This half-term our theme will be Superheroes

Week One and Two: Supertato

Key Book: Supertato!

We will think about all the real life superheroes that help us on a daily basis. We will be exploring non-fiction books about real life superhereos and writing our own information text.

Week Seven: I am a Superhero

Key Book: Super Duper You

This week we will be thinking about all the things we have achieved this year.

How to help at home:

Make up a superhero — draw/paint or make a 3D version. Have a go at labelling your picture. Write about their superpowers. Find out about real life superheroes from books or the internet.

Writing

In our English lessons the children will be writing their own sentences independently. We will be learning to compose, remember and write our sentence using capital letters, spaces and full stops.

Handwriting

We will be continuing our daily handwriting lessons, learning to write capital letters as well as reviewing all the letter families. During all our writing activities will be focusing on forming our letters correctly as well as trying to position them on a line correctly.

Maths

Doubling

Even and Odd

We will learn that some quantities will share equally into 2 groups and some won't. We will start to recognise the odd and even structure using number shapes.





Deepening Understanding

Towards the end of the term we will start to engage in problem solving, thinking about how to solve a problem and finding ways to find a solution.

Patterns and Relationships

We will be learning to copy, continue and create repeating patterns.
