Read Write Inc. Phonics daily lessons

 We teach sounds, practice reading and spelling words with these sounds, then give children decodable books containing sounds and words they can read.











INFANT SCHOOL AND NURSERY

- 10 minutes every day.





What is phonics?

- Sounds all words are made up of individual sounds.
- Graphemes the name for the letters we use to write the sound.
- Phonics is a method of teaching reading through the identification of sounds and graphemes





English alphabetic code

- 44 sounds
- 26 letters
- Over 150+ grapheme (letter combinations)
- One of the most complex alphabetic codes in the world.



Speed Sounds Set 1

- We teach using pure sounds.
- We pronounce sounds clearly.


