Year N - Nursery

This week we have read the story 'How About a Night Out'. We have continued to focus on the difference between day and night by describing what we do and what it looks like outside at these times of the day. In Maths we have continued to learn about counting groups of objects and learning when to stop the count. We have compared the heights of the buildings within our story and matched them to Numicon pieces. The children have also been discussing the signs and logos we might see and have been learning to recognise some familiar ones, such as Tesco, McDonalds, CBeebies etc.

Makaton signs for this week were: cat, dog, light, dark, yes and no.

In Maths this week we have explored one more and one less. We have used 5 frames and cubes to support us.

We have loved exploring a bigger garden area where we have used the bouncy hopper, scooters, balls and tunnel.

Year 1

In Year 1 the children have been thinking about instructions and how important it is to have instructions in the correct order. The children have been writing their own instructions on how to take care of a Bog Baby, thinking carefully about the order of the steps getting his home ready and learning about 'bossy' verbs. In Maths the children have learnt about the names and features of 2-D and 3-D shapes, as well as sorting shapes and making patterns with shapes. In Design and Technology the children have been following their own designs for making fruit kebabs, they then evaluated their final product.

Year 2

Year 2 have been hard at work again this week and have been brilliant authors! The year 2 children have been writing their own stories using the Penguin character from class text 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers. They have planned and written their own stories of how the Penguin left the South Pole in search of a new friend and ended up at the Boy's red door. In Maths we have continued building on our multiplication knowledge, with a focus on the 5x and 10x tables. Maybe practise at home by logging into TTRockstars. We have continued with our Geography theme and have been comparing Antarctica and The Arctic looking at some of the differences and similarities.
