- Set 2 sounds are shaded. They are long vowel sounds with 2 or more letters – **Special Friends**.

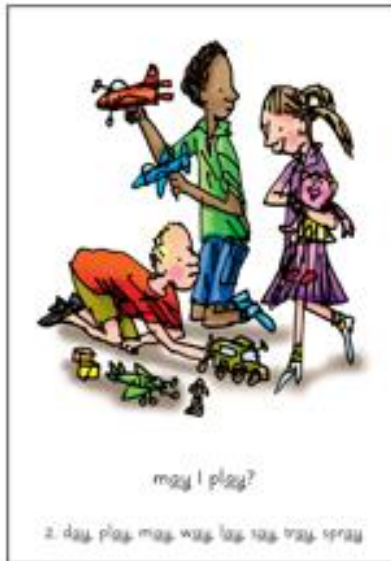

- Once children know how to read Set 2 sounds, they start to learn Set 3 sounds.
- They are alternative graphemes (spelling of a sound) for the Set 1 and Set 2 sounds.

One-to-one tutoring – ‘keep up, not catch up!’

- Some children need extra practice.
- 10 minutes every day.



What can you do?

1. Practise the sounds and phrases
2. Practise reading sounds speedily – review, review, review
3. Use Special Friends, Fred Talk, read the word
4. Listen to your child read their storybook/bookbag every day
5. Read stories to your child every day
