This week we will be learning about real life superheroes and enjoying a visit from our local police officers and finding out all about them.

This week we will be learning about different kinds of feelings and linking these to the ten little superheroes.

This week we will be learning to run on a track in preparation for sports day.

Pom Pom is Super:

This week we will be learning to talk about and describe feelings. We will also be looking at different parts of the day.

This week our learning will be around the book 'Worrysaurus' as part of our transition events. We will be talking about how we are feeling and the changes as we move into big school.

My Mum is a Superhero:

We continue our learning about real life superheroes by reading the book My Mum is a Superhero. We will be thinking about all the special people that are superheroes to us.

I am a Superhero:

During our last week of term, we will be celebrating the time we have had at nursery and all the friends we have made. We will be thinking about all the exciting adventures we will have as we move into big school after the summer holidays.

How to help at home:

We will be sending out a letter with the QR codes for RWI videos for you to watch at home with your child.

It will help your child to remember the sounds that we have been learning at school.

To help your child develop their oral blending skills there are also Fred talk videos to practise. Another way to help with oral blending is to sound out words for example "Can you get your b-a-g".

Literacy

We will be continuing our daily RWInc lessons, learning three new sounds a week and practising our oral blending skills.

Longed Legged Giraffe Letters



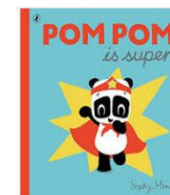
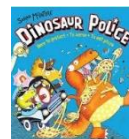
Storytime
